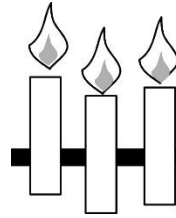

Message from our Pastor 

My Dear Friends, please read this article by **Jeremiah R. Grosse**, "The Issues of Trust."

For many people the issue of trust is something that they struggle with all of their lives. They put their trust in various people and they are disappointed time again. In most cases, they are not placing their trust in people who are intentionally trying to cause this person harm; however, they are fallible human beings who for one reason or another cannot live up to the expectation of those who placed their trust in them. At the time that Psalm 146 was written the Jewish people were in exile in Babylon and could not place their trust in their captors. With each successive generation, they were feeling more and more removed from their Jewish roots for the older members of the community it must have felt as if their Jewish faith might be lost forever. While it is true that we are all fallible human beings, it is also true that there are people out there who will give you the shirt off their back, literally or figuratively. These are the people who only need to hear that you are in trouble and they will drop everything and come to your aid. The Book of Ecclesiastes states that such a friend is worth his or her weight in gold. It is people such as this who bring the love of God to others by helping to restore justice for those who are wronged, giving food to the hungry, helping to set those imprisoned by sin free by their witness, helping those who are blind to the presence of God in their lives encounter Him through their love and concern, and allow those who are bent over from carrying the weight of the world on their shoulders to stand up straight by helping to lighten their friend's load.

The Book of Ecclesiastes is correct. Such a friend is truly worth his or her weight in gold and by doing whatever we can to be of service to others we can become such a friend to them and transform not only their lives, but our own in the process.

Esta alegría se comunica especialmente al que padece tribulación y está a punto de abandonarse a la desesperanza. El salmo 145 canta la fidelidad del Señor a sus promesas y su cuidado por todos aquellos que sufren. Santiago, constatando que la llegada del Señor está ya muy cerca, invita a todos a tener paciencia: así como el labrador espera la lluvia, el alma espera al Señor que no tardará. El Evangelio, finalmente, pone de relieve la paciencia de Juan el Bautista quien en las oscuridades de la prisión es invitado por Jesús a permanecer fiel a su misión hasta el fin.

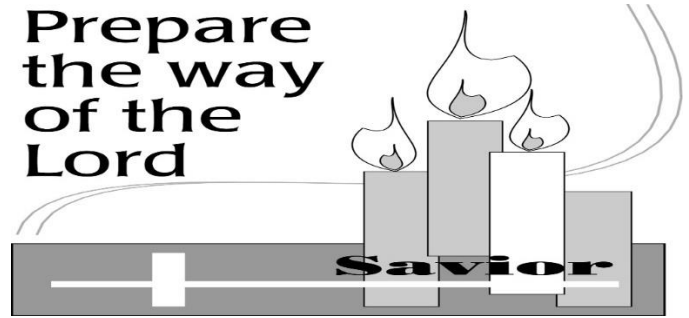
