Message from our Pastor 

“On Sundays and other holy days of obligation the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass (CCC 2180).”

My dear friends,

As we begin our summer vacations, let us remember that we begin our profession of faith, by saying “I believe.” These two words should be in our **minds, hearts, and behavior** as Catholics.

Enjoy your summer break with your family and friends, but remember the importance for those of us who profess “**I believe.**” It is important to attend church regularly as our commandment states, “remember to keep holy the Sabbath.”

I can remember when I was 10 years old and my family went on vacations. The first assignment my parents accomplished while on vacation was to find a Catholic Church. For our family, it is vital that we attend Sunday mass, before we engage in any other summer activities. I encourage and challenge ALL to establish this habit with your children, families, and friends, so that your relationship with our Father in Heaven, continues to grow and prosper.

This weekend we celebrate the **Body and Blood of our Lord and Savior (Corpus Christi)**. What does the Body and Blood of Christ mean to us? It is imperative to realize that if we miss mass on Sunday, we cannot receive communion, until we have gone to confession. *“The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor. Those who deliberately fail in this obligation commit a grave sin (CCC 2181).”* One cannot miss mass, and think that it is okay to receive Holy Communion, if you have not gone to confession. I ask the question again, **“Do we believe?”**

Happy Father’s Day to ALL the Fathers of our Catholic Community. May this day be example that we exemplify to our families and friends that Jesus Christ is Lord and we **BELIEVE!**

Reflexión

Vamos a reflexionar sobre el tema: Eucaristía banquete fraternal. La misa es un banquete, una comida. Y en ella nos encontramos con todos los invitados a esta cena. Y todos juntos formamos una comunidad de tipo familiar, una comunidad de hermanos.

Ya sabemos que el Señor dijo su primera Misa durante el curso de un banquete, en la Última Cena. Y la Iglesia ha seguido siempre esta tradición: su Misa es ante todo un banquete.

Ahora, la Eucaristía es un banquete fraternal. En ella nos encontramos no sólo con el Padre de la familia, sino también con nuestros hermanos. La unión con Cristo en la Eucaristía tiene que abrirnos también hacia los demás invitados. Con todos ellos hemos de encontrarnos en una buena comunión y la gracia, como un río, circulará de nosotros hacia ellos y de ellos hacia nosotros.

Cristo. El estar comiendo el mismo Pan de Cristo es lo que nos va convirtiendo, poco a poco, en su Cuerpo Místico, Cuerpo de los hijos de Dios.

Cristo, en la Eucaristía, se hace Cristo de la unidad, Cristo de la fraternidad, Cristo de la paz entre los hermanos. Él viene a unir a los hombres con el Padre y a los hombres entre sí. Y aquel que entra en comunión con Él, participa de ese misterio de filiación y de fraternidad que Cristo vino a traernos.

Y nosotros, ¿cuándo nos sentiremos, al salir de la Eucaristía, tan felices, tan renovados, tan fraternales - como ellos? ¿Cuándo nos daremos cuenta de que - como aquella primera vez - Dios había estado presente entre nosotros y nos había unido como familia de hermanos?
